

## The Coffey Prize in Geotechnical Engineering

### PRIZE RULES

#### **Establishment**

This Prize has been established by a contribution to the University by Coffey Geosciences Pty. Ltd.

In support of the prize Coffey Geosciences Pty. Ltd. shall provide to the University as a result of a pledge request, an annual amount equivalent to \$300.00 (GST free).

#### **Value**

The value of the Prize will be \$300.00 per year, until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the contributor.

#### **Eligibility**

The prize will be awarded annually by the University to eligible students enrolled in the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil and Structural) or Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil and Environmental) degree program or associated double degrees with a Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil and Structural) or (Civil and Environmental) component.

#### **Selection of Candidate**

The Head of the School of Civil, Environmental and Mining or nominee will award the prize to the Level III student and who distinguishes themselves in both the theoretical and practical components of the course C&ENVENG 3012 Geotechnical Engineering Design III.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year and the money will be used in subsequent years.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize shall be shared equally.

#### **Variations**

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
