PRIZE RULES

Establishment

This Prize has been established by the School of Civil, Environmental and Mining Engineering (CEME) to recognise the best Level IV Research Project in the area of Geotechnical Engineering.

Value

In support of the prize the School of Civil, Environmental and Mining Engineering shall provide each recipient with a bound copy of their thesis and a ticket to the CEME annual dinner.

Eligibility

The prize will be awarded annually by the University to eligible students enrolled in the following level IV courses:

C&ENVENG 4222A/B Research Project Part A & B

Selection of Candidate

The Head of School of Civil, Environmental and Mining Engineering or nominee will award the prize to the group of students who are deemed to complete the best research project in the area of Geotechnical Engineering based on the best overall result and the highest overall mark for the group oral presentation.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year

If there is more than one group of candidates of equal merit, then each recipient will receive a bound copy of their thesis.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
