## The Qikdraw Systems Prize PRIZE RULES

### **Establishment**

This Prize has been established by a contribution to the University by Qikdraw.

In support of the prize Qikdraw shall provide to the University as a result of a pledge request, an annual prize in the form of software.

### **Value**

The value of the Prize will be \$1500.00 per year, until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the contributor.

### **Eligibility**

The prize will be awarded annually by the University to eligible students enrolled in the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil & Architectural).

### **Selection of Candidate**

The QIKDraw Systems Prize will be awarded to the student enrolled in in C&ENVENG 1013 *Introduction to Architectural Engineering* who has "most effectively demonstrated significant creativity and innovativeness in research, investigation or project work and has presented this work with the aid of creative CAD techniques".

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year and the money will be used in subsequent years.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize shall be shared equally.

### **Variations**

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
