
The Mechanical and Automotive Engineering Student Prize

PRIZE RULES

Establishment

This Prize has been established by the School of Mechanical Engineering to recognise the highest achieving final year Mechanical and Automotive Engineering student.

Value

The prize will be acknowledged with a certificate, or such other item as the University shall from time to time determine.

Eligibility

The prize will be awarded annually by the University to eligible students in the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Mechanical and Automotive) degree who are completing their final year of study in the year of the award.

Selection of Candidate

The Head of School of Mechanical Engineering or nominee will award the prize to the final year student who has completed all of the requirements for the degree and achieves the highest weighted average mark including all courses presented towards the degree.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then each recipient will receive a certificate.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
