

The AAPG Student Chapter Petroleum Geoscience Honours Prize

Establishment

This Prize has been established by a contribution to the University by The American Association of Petroleum Geologists (AAPG) Student Chapter, in recognition of high achieving honours students in the field of petroleum geoscience studying with the Australian School of Petroleum.

In support of the prize the AAPG Student Chapter treasurer shall provide to the University an annual amount of \$500.00 (GST free).

Value

The value of the Prize will be \$500.00 per year until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the contributor.

Eligibility

The prize will be awarded annually by the University to eligible students enrolled in the Bachelor of Science (Honours) degree who are undertaking studies specifically in the field of Petroleum Geology & Geophysics. Students in their final semester of study will be considered for the prize.

Selection of Candidate

The Australian School of Petroleum (or nominee) will award the prize to the Honours student who placed highest in order of academic merit.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year and the money will be used in subsequent years.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize shall be shared equally.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
