

Best Ingenuity GeoScience Project Australian School of Petroleum

PRIZE RULES

Establishment

This Prize has been established by the Australian School of Petroleum to recognise the quality, depth and breadth of project presentation and audience engagement at the annual 'Ingenuity' event in the discipline of Petroleum Geosciences.

Value

The value of the Prize will be \$150 per year for the winning project (if applicable), funded by the Australian School of Petroleum.

Eligibility

The prize will be awarded annually by the University to eligible students enrolled in the following program:

Bachelor of Sciences (Honours) – Petroleum Geology & Geophysics

Selection of Candidate

The Head of The Australian School of Petroleum or nominee will award the prize to the student who is deemed to deliver the best project presentation at the annual 'Ingenuity' event, based on visual presentation (poster and display) and audience engagement at the time of judging.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year.

If there is more than one student of equal merit, then the prize may be shared equally between the recipients.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
