
The Qikdraw Systems Prize PRIZE RULES

Establishment

This Prize has been established by a contribution to the University by Qikdraw.

In support of the prize Qikdraw shall provide to the University as a result of a pledge request, an annual prize in the form of software.

Value

The value of the Prize will be \$1500.00 per year provided in the form of software, until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the contributor.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the prize, students must be undertaking the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil & Architectural) in the year in which the Prize is awarded.

Selection of Candidate

The Qikdraw Systems Prize will be awarded to the student with the best final grade for CEME 1002 *Introduction to Infrastructure*.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize shall be shared equally.
