



# THE ALDERMANN KLEEMAN SCHOLARSHIP

The Alderman-Kleeman Travel Scholarship was set up in recognition of Professor AR Alderman and Dr. AW Kleeman, distinguished leaders in their fields of geology and mineralogy, to support and encourage postgraduate geoscience students in their research.

The scholarship is to be used by the recipient to cover travel costs associated with the research project to present their work at a major international conference, spend periods of time at some of the best geoscience institutes, or visit key geological locations.

The value of the scholarship will be to the value of \$3,000 per year, or such other amount as the University shall time to time determine.

The prize is awarded annually to a higher degree geoscience student (Master of Philosophy or Doctor of Philosophy) who is currently enrolled at the University of Adelaide in the Faculty of Sciences, School of Physical Sciences, Earth Sciences and whose area of research is in geoscience.
